Pg. 1- ADD/CHANGE Peleus:

"Here's what I want to say: if you decide to fight, lay siege to Troy, you will die. **For hard on the heels of Hector's death your death must come. But gloriously.**"

Pg. 2- CHANGE "Tell **Patroclus** I said hi."

Pg. 7-CHANGE Achilles: "It's okay **Antilochus**. I know."

Pg. 10 CHANGE Ant: "I have a wife and two **grandchildren**."

Pg. 13 ADD Ant: "But you have five thousand **of your men** straining..."

Pg. 15 CHANGE/CUT Antilochus: "winging wild words **at your love**: "Patroclus. You fool. May vultures eat you raw."

Pg. 23 CUT/CHANGE Thetis/Achilles:

Beat.

THETIS: You have no armor."

Pg. 24 ADD Thetis: add: "I'll take care of it. **(correcting) You.**"

Pg. 26 ADD Chorus: "They put the ax through the heart of **a** young man."

Pg. 26 ADD Chorus: "Sister... **This was my sister...** This was my"

Pg. 29 CUT Heph: "If I could hide Achilles from death, I would **but. We know the deal.**" Reads: "If I could hide Achilles from death, I would."

Pg. 32 REFORMATING Agamemnon:

“Can’t tell you when WWI ended

Pg. 36 CHANGE

Pg. 36 CHANGE/ADD Lycaon:

Pg. 38 CHANGE Achilles:

Pg. 38 ADD Stage direction:

“And even I won’t survive this war.

Lycaon takes in Achilles’ revelation.

So I’m sorry but-“

Pg. 39 CHANGE Lycaon: “(dying) **That’s Helen, that’s what...** Oh my god...”

Pg. 44 ADD CHARACTER

All TROJAN WOMEN in scene becomes **TROJAN WOMEN/ A FEW TROJAN MEN**

Pg. 47 CUT

TROJAN WOMEN/A FEW TROJAN MEN:

“Face facts:

He’s not stopping until

Your soul

Has been...”

(CUT: When you consider the” though “out the window.”)

Pg. 49 CHANGE

Should now read... Priam:

“Your brother Polydorus, your cousin Lycaon”

Pg. 54 ADD Hector:

“What do you say. **Considering who I am. Who you are. Your curse.** That we call it even. Good ole fashioned spit shake. Okay?”

Pg. 56- NEW PAGE

Pg. 59 CHANGE Agamemnon:

“So you refuse to fight and

Drag Hector’s corpse with your Harley

Which obviously makes you feel”

Pg. 60 CHANGE Agamemnon:

“UM

YOU KNOW MY **GIRLFRIEND**

SHE’S VERY CLEAN”

Pg. 62 CHANGE Patroclus:
